

Colors of Our Lives

1. White figure with 2 faces—a boy and a girl
“When we are born, we are born pure and clean from sin.”
2. Black figure with “SIN” across chest
“But as we grow to the age of accountability, SIN enters our lives. The Bible teaches that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God.”
3. Red figure with picture of Jesus on the cross
“But the blood of Jesus was shed to remove that sin.”
4. Blue figure with baptismal scene (man baptizing person)
“In the watery grave of baptism our sins are washed away.”
5. White figure with “CHRISTIAN” in black letters
“At that point we are a new Christian—a new creature. And once again our lives are pure and clean.”
6. Green figure with flowers
“But we must grow as a Christian. Just as a seed grows into a beautiful flower, we must grow.”
7. Yellow figure with gold crown and heaven in black letters
“And then if we do grow, some day heaven will be our home. If we remain faithful throughout our lives, we will live with God and Jesus in heaven.”

Instructions

Print figure on page 2 as noted above. Use one figure as a pattern to cut around on black paper. Print page 3 on white paper. You might choose to cut the crown out to use for a cutting pattern on gold gift wrap. Glue the symbols to the proper color figure. Laminate. Cut again. Suggested “script” is above.

Pages 4 and 5 are student size copies. Either cut out symbols for students to glue on figures as they review the lesson or print symbols on sticker paper for easy use. Laminating these is not necessary.
